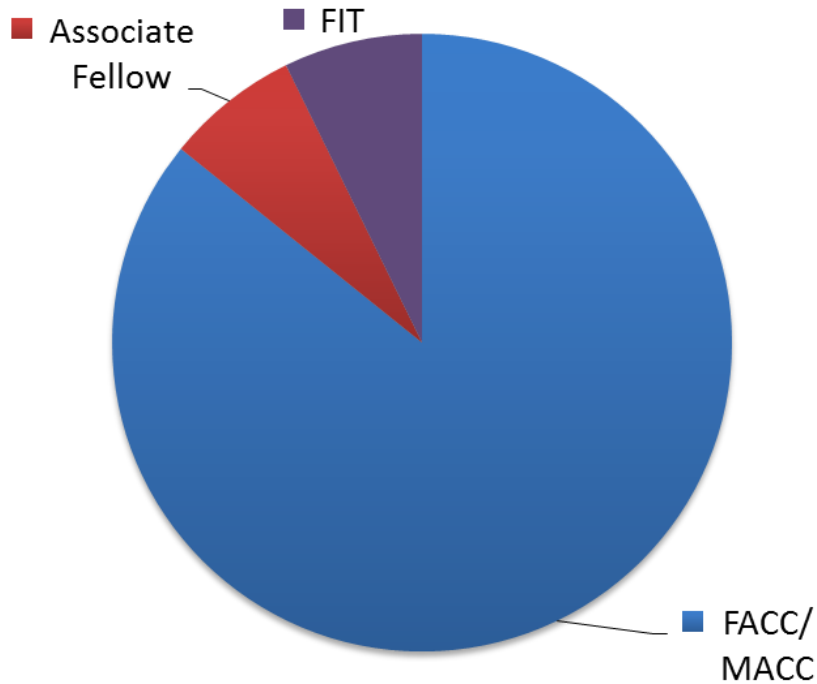

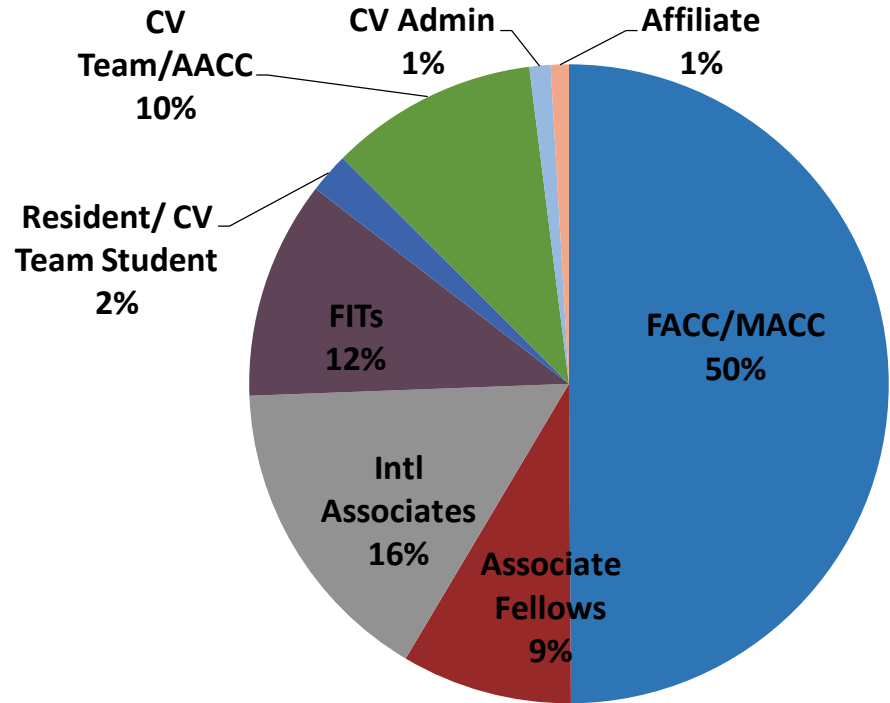

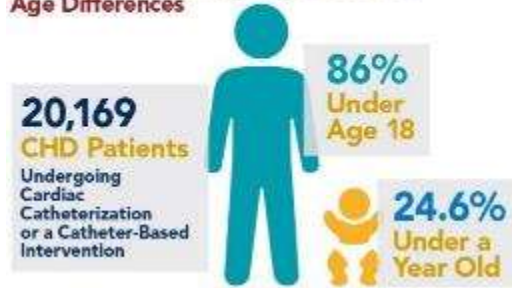

Age Differences



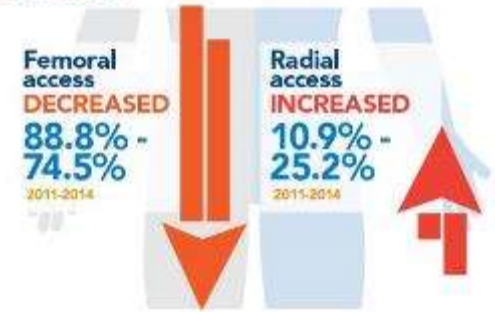

2011-2014

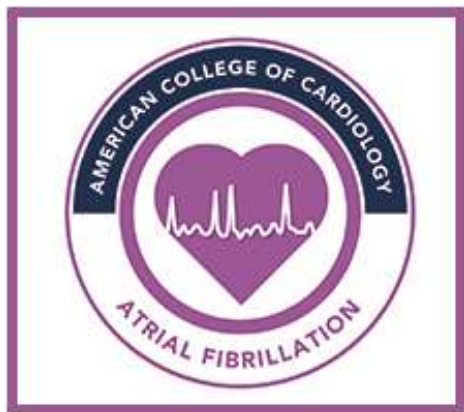
