

Heather L. Gornik, MD is Co-Director of the Vascular Center and Interim Chief Quality Officer of the Harrington Heart and Vascular Institute of University Hospitals in Cleveland, Ohio and Professor of Medicine at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. She completed medical school at the University of Chicago and internal medicine residency and fellowship in Cardiovascular Medicine and Vascular Medicine at Brigham and Women's Hospital. During her time in Boston, Dr. Gornik served as Chief Medical Resident. Prior to joining University Hospitals in 2019, she was on staff of the Vascular Medicine Section of Cleveland Clinic for 13 years. Dr. Gornik is a clinician-investigator whose work has focused on the rare disease fibromuscular dysplasia (and related entities) as well as non-invasive vascular testing. Throughout her career, Dr. Gornik has worked with national organizations to advance the care of patients with vascular disease through multi-specialty clinical practice guidelines and appropriate use criteria. She recently served as Vice-chair of the 2016 AHA/ACC PAD Guideline and co-chaired of the 2019 International Consensus on FMD. She is the current President of the Vascular Testing Division of the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (IAC) and the Immediate Past-President of the Society for Vascular Medicine (SVM). Dr. Gornik has been the Editor-in-Chief of *Vascular Medicine*, the official journal of SVM, for more than six years.
